Due to limited seating in Memorial Hall, closed circuit television viewing of Commencement will be available in the lobby of Seegers Union (on the plasma screen), in the Red Door located on the lower level of Seegers Union, in the classrooms of Moyer Hall, and in the Lithgow Science Auditorium in Trumbower Hall. **Note:** In the event of excessive heat, closed circuit television accommodations will be available in these areas as well.

**Unless there is a downpour or thunder and lightning, the Commencement ceremony generally continues outside. If rain is expected, please come prepared (umbrella, raincoat, etc.).**
