### **Electronic copy of a journal article retrieved full-text from a database**

#### **New pagination for each issue**

#### **Continuous pagination throughout the volume**

### **Magazine article:**

**Magazine article, no author:**

The rising value of a college education. (2004, Spring). *Presidency*, 7(2), 35.

**NOTE:** When citing a source with no author, use the first significant word in the title to alphabetize the work in the reference list. For the in-text citation, identify the work by a shortened title: (“Rising Value,” 2004).

**Journal article, two authors:**

McVey, H., & Draho, J. (2005). U.S. family-run companies—They may be better than you think. *Journal of Applied Corporate Finance*, 17(4), 134-143.

**Journal article, three to six authors:**

Altman, M., MacDonald, K., & MacDonald, M. (2005). From crayons to computers. *Social Science Computer Review*, 23, 334-346.

**Journal article, more than six authors:**

Kohler, C.G., Turner, T., Stolar, N., Bilker, W.B., Brensinger, C.M., Gur, R.E., et al. (2004). Differences in facial expressions of four universal emotions. *Psychiatry Research*, 128, 235-244.

**Article in an encyclopedia:**

Frierson, C.A. (2001). Peasants and rural laborers. In P.N. Stearns, (Ed.), *Encyclopedia of European social history from 1350 to 2000* (Vol. 3, pp. 149-163). New York: Scribner.

**Article or chapter in a book:**

Rensberger, B. (1996). How genes work. In *Life itself: Exploring the realm of the living cell* (pp. 81-116). New York: Oxford University Press.

**Article or chapter in an edited book:**
