

A durable link to an Ingenta journal must follow an international standard called "Open URL." This standard uses a template which is not pretty but will work as a durable link. This durable link will **only** work in the Muhlenberg network (on campus), **not from off-campus locations through the proxy service**. You must use the following template:

<http://openurl.ingenta.com/content?genre=article&journal=... &article=... &author=...>

and insert as much of the following information as you can:

- Publication title (=title)
- ISSN
- EISSN (also called E-journal ISSN)
- Date
- Volume number
- Issue number
- Start page number (=spage)
- Ending page number (=epage)
- Article Title (=atitle)
- Author (aust and aufirst)
- Ingenta article reference number

Each element must follow an ampersand [&] and precede an equals sign [=].

Normal spaces in the publication title or article title must be filled with a plus sign [+] or the hex value %20. Here is an example

**Title:** Written English: The Making of the Language 1370-1400

**Author(s):** Jeremy Catto

**Source:** Past and Present    **Volume:** 179 **Number:** 1 **Page:** 24 -- 59

**Publisher:** Oxford University Press

Can be formulated:
