

# Study Abroad

Students studying abroad in a Muhlenberg College approved program will be considered enrolled at Muhlenberg College while they are studying abroad. Therefore, Muhlenberg College will be considered the “home school” for Federal Aid purposes (Federal Pell Grants, Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant, Federal Perkins Loan, Federal Student Loans and Federal PLUS loan). In addition, students will be able to use their Muhlenberg College need-based grants and merit based grants towards the invoice for the program.
