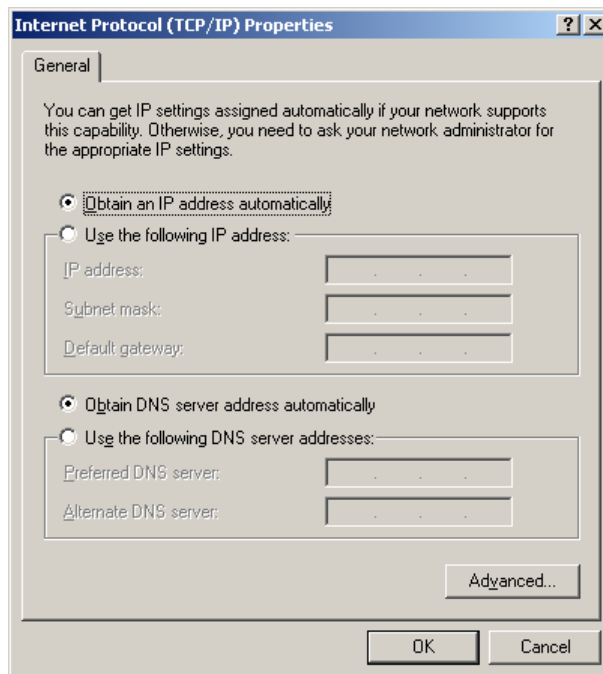


Preparing Your Computer for Campus Network Access

To connect your computer to the Muhlenberg network, a network setting called DHCP must be enabled so your computer will obtain its IP address (network address). Here are the instructions on how to enable DHCP. (Further details for authenticating to the campus network will be provided in your “move-in” packet when you arrive on campus.)

NOTE: Please perform the following instructions before departing for campus. Changing this setting could cause a lost connection with your current Internet Service Provider.

- 1) Go to Start → Settings → Control Panel
- 2) Double-click on “Network Connections” for Windows XP or “Network and Dial-up Connections” for Windows 2000.
- 3) Right Click on your Local Area Network Connection and choose “Properties”.
- 4) In the box click on “Internet Protocol (TCP/IP) and click “Properties”.
- 5) Make sure the “Obtain an IP address automatically” and “Obtain DNS server address automatically” radio buttons are checked.



- 6) Click “OK” and “Close”. There is no need to restart your computer.
