- Sampled terraces and soil on local farms
- Analyzed quantitative and qualitative data
- Keywords identified for conservation agriculture techniques and assessing climate change awareness
- Data was then analyzed using a chi-squared test to compare attitudes and awareness concerning common conservation agriculture techniques
- Descriptive statistics was also used to examine attitudes, awareness, and knowledge of climate change and conservation agriculture in participants of all interviews
- Presented findings to the local community in Tanzania
