MINUTES:

Ms. Lakis confirmed that there is no emergency egress list that was mentioned in last month's minutes. Ms. Lakis made a motion to accept the minutes and Mr. Nemes seconded and was approved by the Committee.

EMERGENCY EGRESS:

Mr. Nemes indicated that the AED parts are good for another year, but, we need to start thinking about replacing units.

Mr. Huber told the committee that fire extinguisher and fire safety will be offered at Staff Development Day this year with small live fire demonstrations.

Ms. Kressler indicated that some fire extinguishers in Trumbower 219, 230, and 238 have not been checked. Ms. Dologite mentioned that the hallway extinguishers in New Science don't have signs.

Ms. Lakis mentioned that speed timing testing from 23rd and Gordon Streets is moving to Liberty Street (across from the stadium) to provide evidence to the City that there is a need for painting and walkways. Mr. Nemeth informed the committee that there is a need for a speed bump between Benfer and the TP due to cars driving too fast.

Ms. Bien Covell informed the committee that CPR and First Aid Certification was provided by Mr. Huber for the Theatre Department.

Ms. Olshefski told the committee that summer theatre training has not been set up because Steve Pakosh, of the Department of Labor & Industry(Bureau of Worker's Comp.), requires at least 25 attendees, and we don't have that amount. Ms. Bien Covell will reach out to the stage manager at DeSales to ask about whether or not our staff could train with their Shakespeare group.
